Dearly Beloved,

May grace and peace from the Father God and our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all!

We are grateful to the Lord for granting us a very good start to the year 2016. All officers and members earnestly started the year, praying and teaching on the year's theme: "Hearing and Obeying the Lord's Voice in my Generation", based on 1 Samuel 3:9-10. Indeed, it is a year of hearing and obeying. The reports that I have received from the officers' retreats are encouraging—apostolisation level was high and officers were greatly impacted. The revelations and prophecies received in some of the areas I went to were encouraging. The Lord reassured His people of making all His resources available for doing His work; people who were 'filthy', 'hurt' and 'sick' were cleansed, healed and restored. The ministrations were powerful and well presented. Some issues on prophetism, such as the devil's attack on the Christian and prayer of vengeance, which were ambiguous in people's minds were settled.

The College of Apostles, Prophets and other heads decided in November that this sort of blessing and ministration should be done at the district and local levels. In view of this, the months of March and April have been set aside to do this exercise. All local, district and area programmes should feature the theme as is presented in the brochure. All district pastors and presiding elders are to prepare programmes to feature their officers to handle specific topics. This should be done ahead of time so that the officer will be able to study and make the material relevant for his or her local assembly. "Confident of your obedience, I write to you, knowing that you will do even more than I ask" (Philemon 21).

In addition to the materials you may have, you can get to The Church of Pentecost's website for other materials from the 2015 November Heads Meetings and the Ministers and Wives Conference in January 2016. You can also get other helpful materials from the website. Furthermore, kindly listen to my teachings on "Prophets" on Pent TV on Tuesdays (Twi) and Thursdays (English), from 6:30am-7:30am with a repeat from 9:00-10:00pm on

both days; there is also a repeat on Saturdays (Twi) and Sundays (English) all at the same time. Other speakers also handle aspects of the theme on Mondays, Wednesday and Fridays at the same time. Kindly make time to listen to these. They will help you.

The way some preachers, claiming to be prophets, are spreading false teachings and practices in the nation is alarming. We need to preach and teach the Word of God, which is the only tool which can destabilise the activities of the evil one. May the Lord grant you grace for this. I agree with Paul, in his admonishing to the Romans:

I urge you, brothers, to watch out for those who cause divisions and put obstacles in your way that are contrary to the teaching you have learned. Keep away from them. For such people are not serving our Lord Christ, but their own appetites. By smooth talk and flattery they deceive the minds of naive people. Everyone has heard about your obedience, so I am full of joy over you; but I want you to be wise about what is good, and innocent about what is evil (Romans 16:17-19, NIV).

As you prepare to celebrate the death and resurrection of Christ, may His very presence be with you. May you have all the blessing of the resurrected and glorified Christ!

May you hear from Him and be obedient to His voice.
